Dear Students,

1. Beginning Monday, January 4, 2021, you will be able to visit our website: <https://bookstore.stvincent.edu/> using either **Firefox or Chrome**, and look up the textbooks needed for your courses for Spring, 2021. You will need to have your schedule handy in order to choose your correct course and section number. Normally, about 50% of our titles will be eligible to rent. If a textbook is eligible to be rented, a price will show up under “RENT” and will have the option of renting or purchasing that title. If a title is eligible to be rented, you will have the option of purchasing that title (USED if available.) Some titles will also have an e-book choice, which you can also purchase online. The LAST day to pre-order your textbooks will be Tuesday, February 2, 2021. After February 2nd, you will need to come into the Bookstore to get your textbooks. **Any orders received after February 2nd will be automatically cancelled.** You may start to purchase your textbooks right in the Bookstore beginning at 8:30AM on Monday, February 1, 2021.

*****We are aware that you have many choices to purchase/rent your textbooks from other sources. We highly recommend that you purchase your textbooks from your College Bookstore. There are certain risks that you take when buying online. At the College Bookstore, you are protected under our returns policy, and are guaranteed to purchase the CORRECT textbook that your professor requires.*****

2. Add your rented and purchased books to your cart. When you are finished, simply checkout. If this is your first time, you will need to create a **NEW** account, and enter your STUDENT ID NUMBER (the last 7 digits on your ID card). **Please create the account under YOUR name and please use your Saint Vincent College email address.**

3. Please choose Business Office Voucher if you do have funds, such as scholarship money or money specifically reserved for textbooks, in the Business Office. You will need your Business Office Voucher to pick up your reserved textbooks.
4. Pre-Ordered Textbooks can then be picked up at the Saint Vincent Gallery (3rd floor of Carey Center) beginning at 1pm – 4pm on Monday, February 1st . Please visit the Bookstore Website during the summer for a complete listing of days & times pre-ordered books can be picked up on campus.
5. The return policy for rented books is the same as books that are purchased. Please be familiar with our Returns Policy located on our website & in the Bookstore. E-books are not refundable if they have been downloaded.
6. Books that are rented will be collected at the end of the semester in the Bookstore. Please make sure you **DO NOT** sell these books at our Textbook Buyback.
